

WE WILL HAVE MEETINGS TO PLAN WHAT WE WILL DO FOR YOU AND HOW WE WILL HELP AND GUIDE YOU. THESE MEETINGS ARE CALLED ME AND MY WORLD REVIEWS AND PLANNING MEETINGS. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU GO TO THESE SO THAT YOU CAN HAVE YOUR SAY.





POCKET MONEY

YOU WILL RECEIVE YOUR POCKET MONEY ON SET DAYS ONCE A WEEK, AFTER YOU HAVE CLEANED AND TIDIED YOUR BEDROOM. THE AMOUNT WILL DEPEND ON YOUR AGE



HAVE YOUR SAY

We regularly have a house meeting where everyone is encouraged to join in with a takeaway and talk about things for the house, how you all feel, anything you'd like for the house or what you would like to do.

We will also talk about food for the house, any worries or issues going on. It is also a really good space to educate you on various topics that could impact your life.

Your social worker.....

Your social worker will visit you regularly to make sure you are ok.

They should visit you a minimum of every 6 weeks to meet with you in private, check your room is ok and that you have no concerns. It is important that you feel able to discuss how you feel and any wishes you may have with them.



ADULTS

OUR ADULTS ARE HERE TO SUPPORT YOU, SPEND QUALITY TIME YOU AND HELP YOU GET THROUGH ANY WORRIES YOU MIGHJT HAVE. AN ADULT WILL ALWAYS BE THERE FOR ANY MEETINGS TO ATTEND WITH YOU AND HELP YPU WITH ALL ASPECTS OF YOUR LIFE.



INSPECTORS....

Sometimes, inspectors will visit the home and they might want to chat to you about what it's like living here. We encourage you to talk to them about how you are feeling here, what you like and anything you may not like.

WHAT IS AN ADVOCATE

An advocate is someone who will support you to express your views and wishes, they will help make sure your voice is heard.

WHAT IS AN CHILD CONFERENCE REVIEWING OFFICER (CRO)?

An CRO is someone who will arrange your review meetings where you and everyone who cares for you will talk about the plans that have been made to make sure you're ok.

They will write to you asking what you think and what you may want to discuss at your review.

They will make sure plans are made that are right for you and they will make sure you are able to say how you feel about them.

They will also look to understand your future plans and goals and how we can all go about achieving them.



EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT.....

All young people are expected, encouraged and supported to attend school, college or work. We will give you all the help and support you need to make a success of it. If you are anxious or worried about education, just talk to us and we will support you!

Placement Plan

We have to write plans about how we will take care of you. We will include your views in these plans and give you copy to keep.

HEALTH

WE LOVE TO EAT!! WE HOPE YOU WILL TRY AND EXPERIENCE NEW AND HELATH FOODS THAT YOU WILL LOVE TO COOK YOURSELF

WE CAN HELP WITH ALL ASPECTS OF YOUR PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL HEALTH, WE WILL PUT YOU IN TOUCH WITH LOCAL SERVICES. ALL ADULTS CAN HELP DIRECT YOU OR SET UP APPOINTMENTS FOR YOU.



WHEN YOU MOVE IN WE WILL ENSURE YOUR ARE REGISTERED WITH THE DOCTOR, DENTIST AND OPTICIANS. IF YOU HAVE ANY WORRIES PLEASE TALK TO US AND WE WILL SUPPORT.

Things to do...

We want you to enjoy as many hobbies as you can and explore any interests you may have. Please let us know if there is anything you are interested in, no matter how wild, and we will do something to support you with this. During school holidays, we like to do lots of activities such as day trips, camping and holidays away.
